Example of a statement: “He/she likes to ride a bike.”

If he/she likes cycling somewhat, put an x on "Somewhat True" whereas if he/she likes it a lot, put an X on “True”.

REMEMBER, there are no right or wrong answers, only answers that best describe him/her.

For this reason, we request you to answer with the utmost SINCERITY.

Some questions may seem similar, but no question is identical!

The questionnaire is long, so give your answer quickly without thinking too much about it, but trying to give the answer that you think best describes him/her!
